### Conditions of Farmers and Workers during Colonial Rule and Today: Views of Annabhau Sathe

#### Abstract:

According to Dr. Suresh Tendulkar's report, in 2004-05, 37.2 per cent of India's population was living below the poverty line. According to the Rangarajan Committee report, in 2011-12, 29.5% of population in India was living below the poverty line. As stated by the then Finance Minister of India, Smt. Nirmala Sitaraman, one third Indian childrens are malnourished and one in three malnourished children in the world is Indian. That is, most malnourished children in the world live in India.<sup>1</sup>

According to the Global Hunger Index, India is ranked 101st out of 116 countries in the world in 2020-21. According to Oxfam, India has a high level of economic inequality, with the richest one per cent of India's national income reaching 73 per cent of the country's national income in 2019-20. The truth of the declaration made by Sahityaratna Annabhau Sathe in this regard on 16th August, 1947, after seeing the miserable condition of India on the 75th anniversary of India's independence, comes to light. The announcement was,

"This freedom is false. The people of the country are hungry."
