The college was established in 1960 with the auspicious hands of Hon'ble Shri Y.B.Chavan, Chief Minister of Maharashtra The College is known for its high academic standards. The funding status is Grant-in-aid. The college is permanently affiliated to Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad and is recognized by UGC under 2(f) and 12B. The college offers 7 UG and 14 PG programmes. The college also offers 4 Ph.D. programmes.

PROGRESS REPORT OF CPE SCHEME

1. Lab Up gradation

- Required furniture procured and installed in the IT Lab. Aluminum partitions were installed in the library. The labs are upgraded.
- Science labs are strengthened by purchasing sophisticated equipment's.
- Interactive boards installed in the ICT labs so as to enhance the quality of teaching learning process.

2. Language Lab Equipment

Orell software has been installed in the Language Lab to support the English speaking activities. Computers, projector and interactive board have also been installed. The college has set up a state of the art Language Lab and using this software students acquire the communication techniques in this lab.

3. Teaching Aids

- Interactive boards have been installed in the ICT, Language Lab, class rooms so as to enhance the quality of teaching learning process.
- Many curricular & co-curricular events are also organized in college premises. So portable speakers were required.

4. Library Automation

 Batteries have been installed in the library so as to provide uninterrupted power supply through the UPS/Inverter.

5. Computers

• Computers, printers have been purchased for IT labs.

6. Software

 MatLab Software has been purchased as per the curriculum of Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University for mathematics and computer science department.



- Firewall Software is purchased to safeguard and protect the computers and data from e-threats.
- As Tally is a component of the Commerce Curriculum (UG), the college purchased Tally ERP 9.0 software.
- ERP software is purchased. The College Administration has been fully computerized and automated. Software has been purchased and installed. The college Library operations have been fully automated. The store operations have been computerized by installing software. Software have been installed in all the Departments.
- The existing website www. mspmbeed.com has been updated and upgraded, new features added.

7. Internet Connectivity

The college provides internet to all the students, teachers and administrative staff. Wireless modem is required to extend this facility. Cable cat, cable patch and installation work is carried out to extend the internet. All the departments have been connected through LAN.

8. Up-gradation of Seminar Hall

- Air cooling system. is installed in Seminar Hall. This facility has been installed in the recently upgraded Auditorium that accommodates 295 audiences. To upgrade the auditorium 295 cushioned chairs have been laid.
- The electrification work was done in the Auditorium and fittings have been changed. LED lighting is installed. Switches also installed.

9. Sports and Cultural activities:

Sport and cultural dept. are strengthened by purchasing sports and musical instruments respectively.


